Registration

A \$100.00 registration fee is mandatory for all programs and is in addition to tuition fees.

Tuition

Journeyman Make-up Artistry Program (400 clock hours) \$ 7,650.00

This program contains the *beauty make-up artistry* and *character make-up artistry* courses and prepares students for employment within the entertainment industry.

Fashion Make-up Artistry Program (400 clock hours) \$ 8,200.00

This program contains the *beauty make-up artistry*, *studio hairstyling* and *portfolio development* courses and prepares students for employment within the fashion and cosmetic industry.

Make-up Artistry II Program (640 clock hours) \$ 12,890.00

This program contains the *beauty make-up artistry*, *character make-up artistry*, *studio hairstyling* and *portfolio development* courses and prepares students for employment within the fashion and cosmetic industry.

Make-up Kits & Materials
